A telephone response is not adequate; the response must be in writing. Mail your reply to the above address. As an alternative you may send your reply via email to hallinen@yahoo.com. A response will be emailed to you upon receipt of your email. If you do not get a reply within 72 hours you should assume that we did not receive your email. It is then your responsibility to try again, either by email or regular mail. A copy of your reply, minus your name, will be posted to the encroachment report that is published on the web. Please review the Encroachment Abatement Procedure at

http://dunhamlake.com/rules/encroachmentabatement.htm.. It is your responsibility to be familiar with this document. This policy requires the DLPOA to impose fines on Lot Owners who do not comply with the Common Area Management Policy, in addition to legal action.

In your letter you must tell us that the encroachment has been resolved. You are also directed to abide by the Common Area Management Policy's rules in the future.

An encroachment report will be published in the upcoming Dunham Laker. The complete report, as submitted to the Board, will be published on the web site Dunhamlake.com. An image of your possible encroachment is on the web site. A report will also be presented at the annual meeting.
